Fostering

We want to thank our foster families and explain why fostering is such an important step between trapping and adoption.

1. Newly trapped feral kittens have very little experience with humans, and they are fearful and suspicious.
2. By giving them their own space in a spare room or bathroom, they will respond to gradual contact with humans.
3. With patience and care from the foster family, kittens will become loving and adoptable.
